MI Works Already Hiring Snow Plow Drivers

There are at least a few job opportunities here in Southwest Michigan that will be popping up in the coming weeks. The Michigan Department of Transportation needs part time plow drivers to help clear state roads once the snow starts to fall, and it's enlisted the aid of Michigan Works to find such people. Spokesperson Megan McCausland tells us that they'll be hiring 30 individuals, at a rate of between 14 and 18 dollars an hour to do work between around November and March.
